

この度、ギャラリーへプタゴンでは米シカゴのアーティスト、ジャクリン・メドニコフの個展を開催いたします。

メドニコフは絵画・彫刻・陶芸・インスタレーションなど領域をまたいで表現活動をしているアーティスト。これまでもたびたび京唐紙の丸二とのコラボレーションなどをおこなってきました。今回は2024年後半から半年にわたる日本滞在中(佐賀・有田、徳島・アワガミファクトリー、京都・丹後)に、各地のさまざまな自然と対話しながら生まれた作品群を早春の京都にて展覧いたします。

メドニコフはカンザス大学で美術学士号、イースタン・イリノイ大学でスタジオ・アートの修士号、シカゴ美術館でアート・インスティテュートを取得、同校で絵画とドローイングの修士号を取得。

アーティストレジデンスとしてこれまでに、Vermont Studio Center(バーモント州ジョンソンシティ)、Ragdale Foundation (イリノイ州レイクフォレスト)、The European Ceramic Workcentre(オランダ)、京からかみ丸二にて唐紙制作・京都)などで滞在制作しています。主な個展・二人展に「Beneath the Green」ゴールドフィンチギャラリー(イリノイ州シカゴ)「A Faint Shadow Trace」Paris London Hong Kong gallery (P.L.HK gallery, シカゴ)、「In Progress」SEA Foundation(ティルブルグ、オランダ)、「In Conversation」ターブル・アーツ・センター(イリノイ州チャールストン)など。

主なグループ展に ハイドパーク・アートセンター (シカゴ)、北イリノイ大学美術館 (イリノイ州デカルプ)、DOCUMENT (シカゴ)、ADDS DONNA (シカゴ)、Morlan Gallery (ケンタッキー州レキシントン)、The Franklin (シカゴ)。

メドニコフの作品は以下の雑誌『New American Paintings』、『Sheridan Road』、『Printmaking Today』『LUXE Interiors』(近刊)などで紹介されています。

現在、シカゴ美術館付属美術学校絵画・デッサン科講師を務めています。

最近では2024年の12月に徳島のアワガミファクトリーにて客員アーティストを務めました。

In her solo exhibition at Gallery Heptagon, Mednicov presents work in washi, textile, and ceramic media that investigate permanence and transformation through a regional naturalistic lens.

Dimensional washi works encasing local flora were developed in residence at Awagami Factory in Tokushima, Japan. Ceramic works informed by a range of plant matter were produced at Studio Yuka Kikumoto in Arita, Japan.

Mednicov also developed a limited-edition tufted rug in collaboration with Kyoto-based weaver, Toyoshima Mikiya. Drawing from Toyoshima's garden as a source, Mednicov produced a monoprint that was subsequently transformed into a lush shadow image of ever changing nature.

ジャクリン・メドニコフは、このギャラリー・ヘプタゴンでの個展で、和紙・テキスタイル・陶器などのメディアを使い、地域の自然主義的なレンズを通して永続性と変容を探求する作品を発表します。

地元の植物を包んだ立体的な和紙作品は、徳島のアワガミファクトリーで2024年の12月に制作されたもの。様々な植物からインスピレーションを得たセラミック作品は、有田の陶芸家菊本有花のスタジオで制作されました。また、メドニコフは京都・丹後の織元、豊島美喜也とのコラボレーションで限定タフテッドラグも制作しました

また、メドニコフは豊島氏の庭を素材にモノプリントを 制作し、その後刻々と変化する自然の緑豊かな影のイ メージへと変化させたのです。
